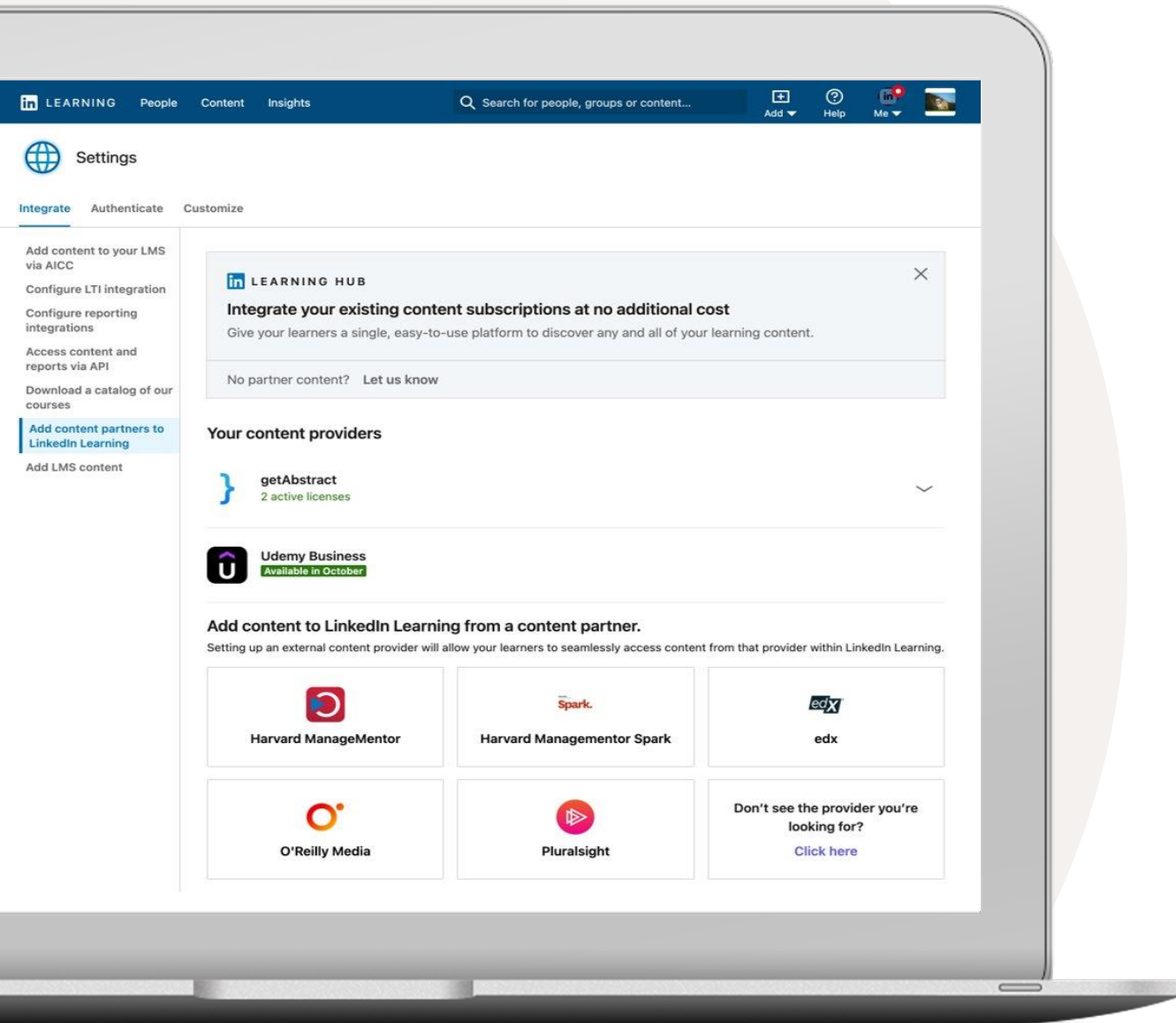

Integrate your content subscriptions

- 1 Go to your name and select 'Integrate' from your dropdown. This should automatically go to the Settings section for your integrations.
- 2 Scroll to the bottom and select the option 'Add content partners.'
- 3 Based on which content partner(s) you are subscribed to, you can enable the following integrations:
 - getAbstract
 - Harvard ManageMentor
 - Harvard Managementor Spark
 - edX
 - O'Reilly
 - Pluralsight

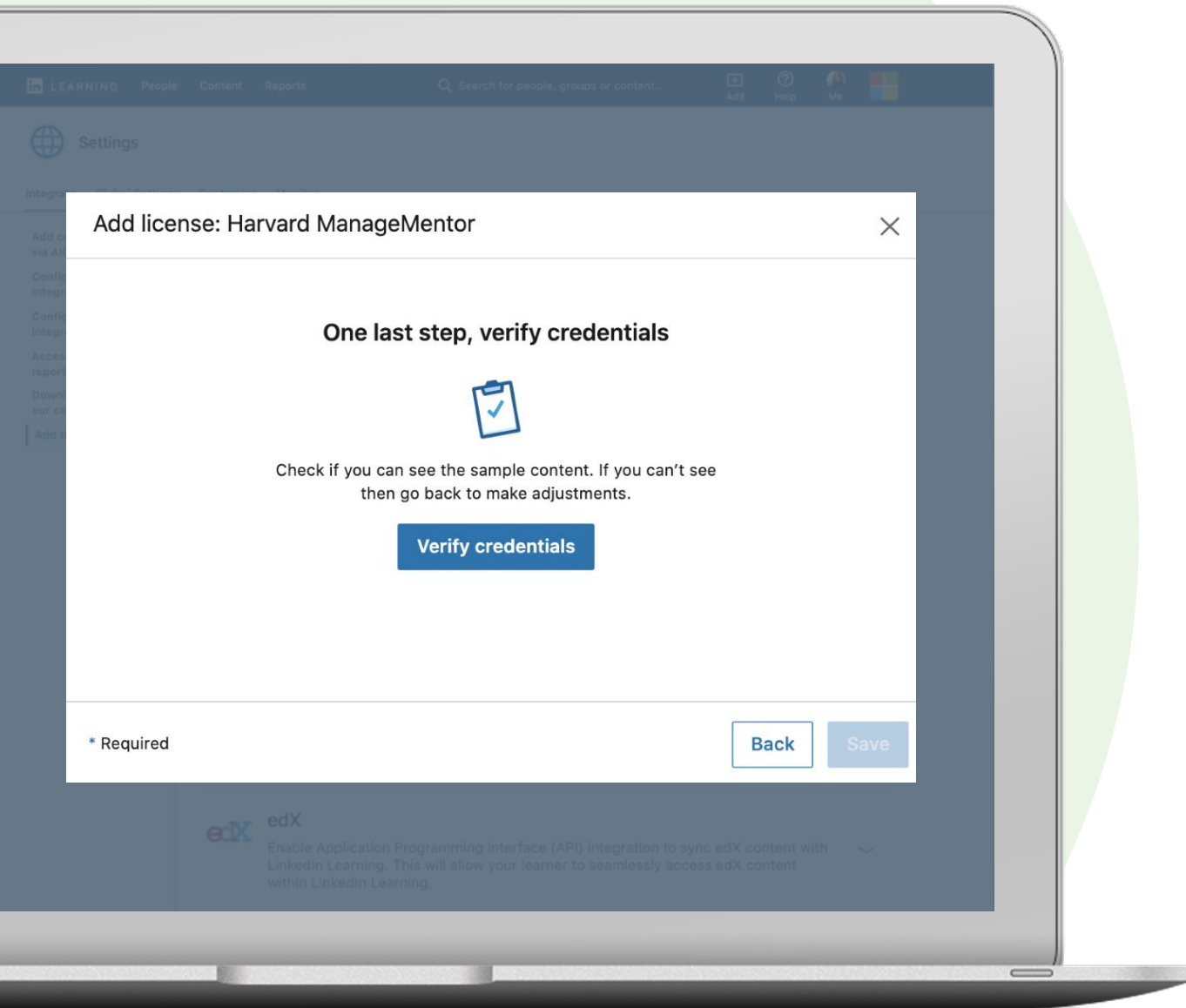
Set-up Harvard ManageMentor

- 1 Enter a name of your choosing for the license name.
- 2 Enter your SSO subdomain.
- 3 Select which content is imported, either 'All' or 'Topic'. If you have licenses for both Harvard ManageMentor and Spark, please select 'Topic' from the dropdown.
- 4 Select which languages your subscription supports.
- 5 Determine which learners and groups can access HMM content by granting access to all learners or certain groups. If enabling for certain groups, please create a LinkedIn Learning group first for those learners and select 'enable for certain groups'.
- 6 Select 'Next' to continue.

Tip: If you have licenses with both Harvard ManageMentor and Spark, you will need to follow the steps for both and select "Topic" in the Content Imported Step. Contact your HMM representative for your unique SSO subdomain. For the content visibility step, please create a LinkedIn Learning group first, if you select the option 'enable for certain groups'.

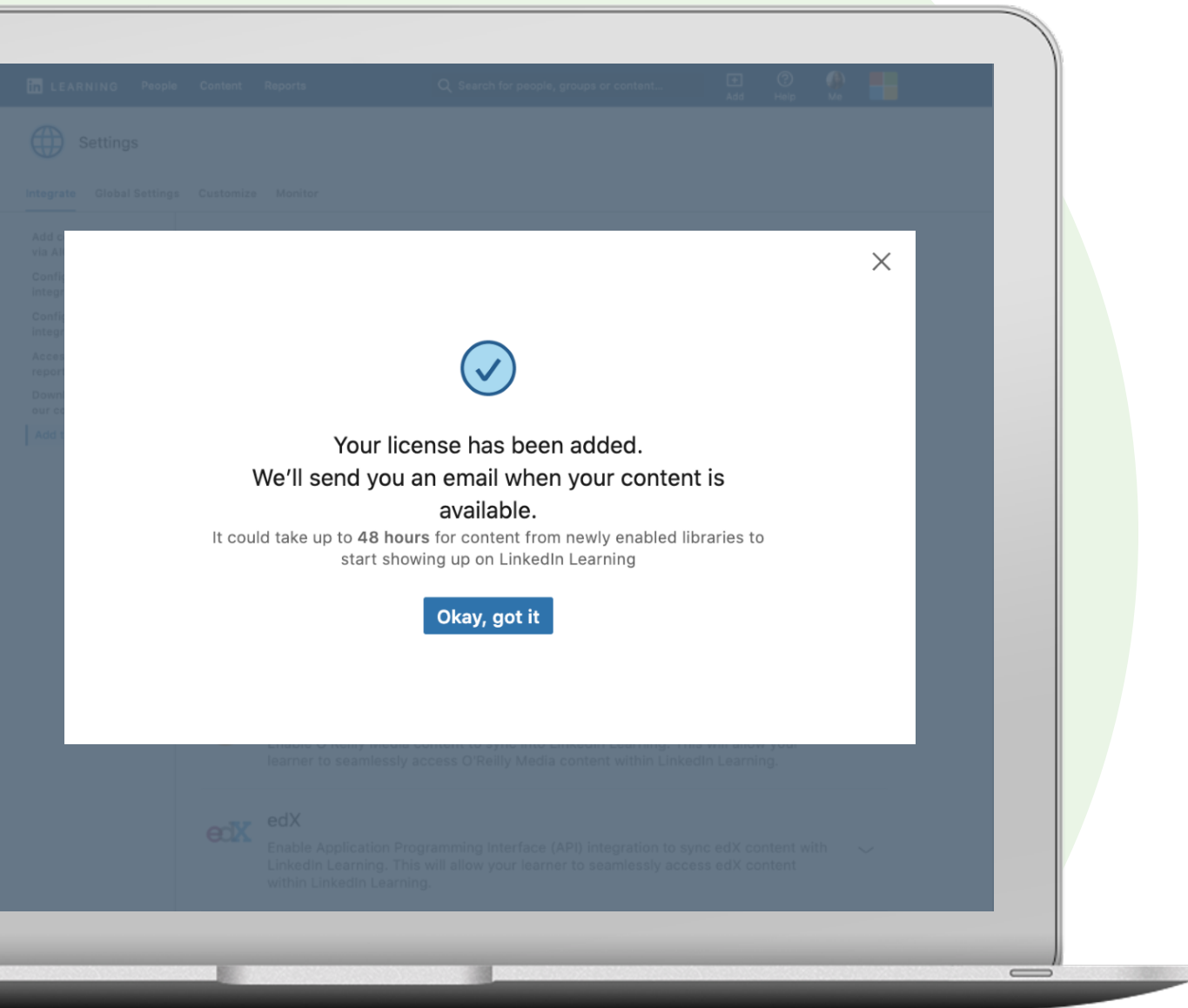
Set-up Harvard ManageMentor

- 7 Select 'Verify Credentials'.

By hitting verify, this will open up a piece of sample content from the provider. Upon logging in via your company SSO, if you are able to view it, then your SSO subdomain is correct.

- 8 Select 'Save' to continue.

Tip: Please contact your HMM customer success representative to obtain the SSO subdomain for your organization. If your SSO URL is 'acme.myhbp.org' then your SSO subdomain is 'acme'.

- 9 Select "Okay, got it."
